In the face of monumental bungles by the Bush government, Iraq debacle, illegal detention and the glaring illegalities perpetrated on the domestic (spying) front, no determined opposition can be detected. It's full steam ahead for the neo-cons and their allies - an astounding situation in view of recent American history.

In the world of politics and war failure to take advantage of an opponent's weaknesses is unforgivable and often proves to be extremely costly.
