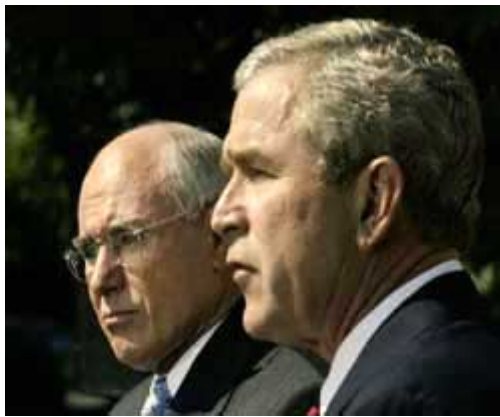


Collusion and Interference in State Institutions
